

**Medical Instructions**  
**(2-4 people 9:30 am – 4pm)**

Thanks for helping out at the Cherry Pie Road Race!

Please arrive at the Valley Catering building (6097 NE Ebony Lane, Adair Village) at 9:30. Here you will receive a map, instructions and a FRS radio that should be tuned to channel 3-15. CPRR has two sessions, the first starting at 10:00am and the second starting at 12:30pm. The entire race should be over by 4pm.

Please sign-in and fill out a volunteer waiver. Leave the waiver at sign-in.

We would like to have medical personal stationed at the finish line on Palestine Ave. and the registration area. These are the two main areas that racers will be looking for/requiring medical attention. If only one location is possible, then it should be the finish line.

Make sure there are OBRA (Oregon Bicycle Racing Association) Medical Occurrence forms included with your packet. Contact Jim Fischer if these forms are not included. We need you to fill them out for anyone you treat at the race.

We do not have any first aid supplies, so you will need to provide your own.
