

Registration Rover Volunteer Instructions
(2 volunteers 7am-1pm)

THANK YOU FOR HELPING TO MAKE THE CHERRY PIE RR POSSIBLE!!!

Your job is to point the racers in the right direction for registration. For this job you will want to **dress warmly**. This will help speed-up the registration process and hopefully stop racers from standing in the wrong lines. Basically, every racer must be registered but they must first have an OBRA racing license.

Fill out the volunteer sign-in sheet and complete an OBRA waiver. Leave the waiver with the volunteer sign in sheet.

The Cherry Pie race entry has the OBRA waiver “built-in”. (Often, the OBRA Entry/Release of Liability is separate from the Race Entry form. Experienced racers may have a pre-printed generic OBRA entry/release. We need them to fill out one specifically for the Cherry Pie.)

ALL RACERS WILL NEED PICTURE IDENTIFICATION TO REGISTER.

There will be four types of racers:

1. NOT REGISTERED and WITHOUT an OBRA LICENSE

This racer needs to fill-out the OBRA License Application (Annual or One-day) at the OBRA table. Once they have their OBRA license, they need to register for the race at the registration table.

2. REGISTERED and WITHOUT an OBRA LICENSE

This racer needs to fill-out the OBRA License Application (Annual or One-day) form at the OBRA table. Once they have their OBRA license, they need to sign-in at the pre-registration table.

3. NOT REGISTERED but has an OBRA LICENSE

This racer needs to fill-out the race registration form. Then they need to register for the race at the registration table. They will need to show their OBRA license.

4. REGISTERED with an OBRA LICENSE

This racer needs to sign-in at the pre-registration table and show their OBRA license.
