

Follow Car Volunteer Instructions
(1 for each field x 6 fields 9:30-11:30 AM, & 12:00-4:00 PM)

THANK YOU FOR HELPING TO MAKE THE CHERRY PIE RR POSSIBLE!!!

Your job is to follow the main pack of your assigned category. By doing this you will provide mechanical support for the racers and keep track of the poor racers that have been “shot out the back” and left behind if instructed to do so by the official. Don’t be afraid to ask them what you should do, but don’t chatter on the radio, either. We’re all on the same frequency.

1. Fill out the Cherry Pie Entry and Release of Liability and leave at Registration.
2. Locate the envelope with your instructions and vehicle signs. Sign out a radio & flasher. A piece of paper under the flasher and the radio antenna will help protect the vehicle’s paint. A notepad is a good idea to note any issues (misbehaving riders, civilians, etc.)
3. Turn on the radio and make sure that you can communicate with the official that is assigned to your field. Channel 3-15.
4. Turn on your vehicles hazard lights. Note your mileage.
5. Hit the restrooms one last time.
6. Make sure you pick up a good smattering of wheels for your field. Write down what you picked up (number and name, wheel type, etc). Put the wheels into the car in a way that’s easy to remember. (e.g. fronts in the back seat, rears in the way back with shimano on the left, campy on the right, etc.) A bed sheet is a good way to keep the car clean.
7. Drive to the start area.
8. **Have the Vehicle Whip mark your car with the field you are following and follow car.**
Example: “men 5 follow”
9. Follow the main field
10. The official will give you instructions detailing when you will pass straggling racers.
11. If you provide any wheels, make sure to write down the racer receiving the wheel (number) and the wheel you gave them.
12. Riders may opt to give you clothing, empty bottles or trash. They must pull up to the driver side window.
13. When you pass a racer from you assigned category write down their bib number. You will give this list to the finish line area after the race.
14. At the finish, drive well past the finish line before parking.
15. Remember to deposit the wheels as soon as you are done with your race.
16. Collect any notes you made and give them to your official.
